Texas High Schools

Register.Vote.BeHeard!

- Twice a year, high school principals must offer students the chance to register to vote if they are 18 years old or will turn 18 years old that school year.
- Each principal of a public or private high school shall serve as a deputy registrar for the county in which the school is located.



What does the code say about registering students at your high school?

- A High School Deputy Registrar may:
 - Distribute and accept voter registration applications submitted to the deputy in person from students and employees of the school only;
 - Review an application for completeness out of the applicant's presence. A deputy may deliver a group of applications to the registrar by mail in an envelope or package, and for the purpose of determining compliance with the delivery deadline, an application delivered by mail is considered to be delivered at the time it's receipt by the registrar.
- Each application form distributed must be accompanied by a notice informing the student or employee that the application may be submitted in person or by mail to the Voter Registrar Office.
- You may request voter registration applications from the Texas Secretary of State's office. You must provide the address where package will be mailed to and the amount being requested to:
